Dr Bike Mechanic Exposure to COVID-19	Dr Bike Mechanic Contracting COVID-19	<p>During the COVID-19 epidemic and pandemic London Bike Hub's first responsibility is to protect its workforce and customers from the virus.</p> <p>The risk will be managed as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bikes to be serviced will be dropped off near the Dr Bike location. • Bikes will have a labelled tag with the name of the person, the time it was dropped off and contact number if any. • The labelled tag should also include a brief description of any obvious issues that need fixing • All bikes will be wiped down with methylated spirits prior to them being checked, which include the handlebars, main bike frame and seat area, i.e. area's that are most commonly touched by hand contact. 	5	2	10
